




Defense Day Celebration 2024-25










Secrat Week & Milad Un Nabi 2024-25

















Weird Hat Day 2024-25










Parent Teacher Conference & After School Clubs Exposition 2024-25










Speech Competition 2024-25










Recreational Trip 2024-25



As we look back at this year's IKSC, we eagerly anticipate the next leap forward in this exciting journey of learning. The best is yet to come!






